FRENCH I & II

French I (FRE 1120) (4 credits)

French I is designed to enable you to express yourself and meet basic needs in spoken and written French. See the text Deux Mondes for specific objectives and outcomes for each unit. You will focus on learning the new vocabulary needed to improve your comprehension and express your ideas. Exposure to diverse French-speaking cultures will be highlighted through authentic audio, video, and written material, including literature, periodicals, magazines, podcasts, film, radio and television programs.

French II (FRE 1121) (4 credits)

French II is designed to focus on real-life language use, the integration of French and Francophone culture and language, and the acquisition of the four skills to expand your skills to communicate by speaking, reading, writing, and understanding written and spoken French. You will learn to communicate in everyday situations through dialogues, oral presentations, projects and group activities.
