 - b. Updates for Knowledge Tier (Legislative Impacts) Marie Bourgeois
 Marie relayed that MGF1130 Mathematical Thinking is a course only present in
 the Knowledge Tier of the Student Learning Objectives (SLO), and that there are
 no SLOs built in. She inquired about what SLOs, if any, should be added to the
 course. Kyna informed the council that, per new Florida regulation, all Gen Eds
 must feature a state approved SLO and a state approved course description.
 Faculty are free to add their own outcomes to courses, but they must not conflict
 with the state-regimented outcomes. All Gen Eds must fit into one of five state

tiers: communication, humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, or mathematics.
