PARKING & TRAFFIC ALERT FOR 8/22

8/21/2024

On Thursday, August 22, parking lots near the Marshall Center will be reserved for the day to facilitate parking for resident student check-in.

High vehicle and pedestrian traffic volumes are expected on USF Holly Drive, USF Laurel Drive, and USF Palm Drive, as well as in the areas surrounding the Marshall Center, the Village, Juniper-Poplar Hall, and the Magnolia Apartments.

Traffic on Holly Drive will run one way eastbound between USF Myrtle Drive and USF Genshaft Drive for resident unloading. **Bull Runner stops on Holly Drive will be out of service.**

Impact on Bull Runner Service: All routes will resume regular service after 5:00 pm.

Routes: Blue, Red, Brown	Regular service, expect delays
Route: Orange	On detour via Fletcher Ave
Routes: Green and Purple	Modified service: routes will be combined on detour

Parking lots in the vicinity of the Marshall Center will be impacted as follows:

Parking Lot	Impact on 8/22
3A, 3B, and 3C	Reserved all day for resident check-in
5D	Closed all day due to the one-way unloading zone on Holly Dr.

Please plan to utilize alternate parking locations within the vicinity of the Marshall Center. These include but are not limited to the Crescent Hill Garage, Laurel Garage, Lots 3E, 9A, 9C, and 42.

Reminder:

- **Virtual Parking Permits:** Your vehicle's license plate will serve as your virtual parking permit. Physical permits are not provided. Learn more at www.usf.edu/virtualparkingpermits
- **Park Plate Out:** With your license plate as your permit, you will need to park "plate out." This means your license plate must be facing the drive lane so it can be read by our License Plate Recognition (LPR) technology.

SUMMER 2024 COMMENCEMENT PARKING & TRAFFIC ALERT, AUGUST 3

Summer 2024 Commencement exercises for USF will be held in the Yuengling Center this Saturday.

High traffic volumes are expected at the Leroy Collins Boulevard and Bull Run entrances off Fowler Ave leading to the Yuengling Center. Parking demand will increase in Yuengling Center lots and other parking lots located along Alumni, Genshaft, Holly Drives, and Leroy Collins Blvd. Please be mindful of increased pedestrian traffic along Alumni, Genshaft, Sago, and Elm Drives as guests arrive and proceed to the Yuengling Center.

Roads and traffic flow around the Yuengling Center will be closed and redirected to provide a safe pedestrian and traffic environment. Bull Run Drive will be closed from the intersection of Alumni Drive north to Elm Drive. Alumni Drive will be closed from the intersection of Leroy Collins Blvd, eastbound to Bull Run Drive.

Road closures for Commencement will begin on Saturday, August 3 at 7:00 am and reopen Saturday, August 3 at 10:00 pm.

Bull Runner service will be impacted with detours on routes Purple, Red, Orange, and Brown on August 3. Normal service will resume on August 3. For more information, please call (813) 974 - 6902 or visit www.usf.edu/parking. You can track Bull Runner buses live at usbullrunner.com.
