

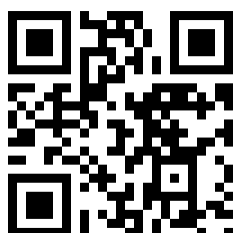
VISITOR PARKING: PARKMOBILE

ParkMobile is a smartphone application that facilitates paying for parking via cell phone.

1. **Download the ParkMobile App** (free to download)
2. Register (setup a free account)
 - o Online at <https://parkmobile.io/>
 - o Or using QR Code on signs.
3. Start Using the Service
 - o Ensure that your current license plate is selected.
 - o Enter the parking zone number manually, by scanning the QR Code, or by utilizing the GPS Functionality.
 - o Select the amount of time to park.
 - o Click the **Start Parking** button to confirm and begin the transaction.
 - o ParkMobile will send an alert 15 minutes before the time expires, so you can choose to extend the period if needed.

Payment is required (24) twenty-four hours a day, (7) seven days a week.

Purchases for Zone 9300 (daily lots) are valid from time of purchase through 11:59 p.m. day of purchase.

Purchases for Zones 9301-9315 are available in (30) thirty minute increments, and have a max duration of (8) eight hours. Park in marked "Timed Space" areas.

If you have received a parking citation and do not wish to contest or appeal it, you may [pay online](#) by credit card over our secure internet site. You may pay in person by credit card or debit card at our parking office at the intersection of USF Holly Drive and USF Plum Drive.

Parking & Transportation Services only accepts payments by credit card or debit card.

To pay by mail, checks or money orders must be mailed to the USF Parking, PO Box 737447, Dallas, TX 75373-7447. Please be sure to include the citation number on the check or money order.

Citations not paid or appealed within 14 calendar days after citation issuance will accrue a late fee and forfeit the right to appeal.

PARKING UPDATE: 5/14/2024

USF Design and Construction informed the College of The Arts this week in a university wide meeting portions of Lots 3B and 3C will be closing starting on Monday, May 20th for a vault drainage project. This construction is scheduled through August and will impact parking for numerous on campus organizations.

Working with PATS (Parking and Transportation Services) Events & Production Services has secured additional lots that can be used for visitor parking if needed during an event.

These locations are Lots 42, 9A, and the 6th floor of the Laurel Garage. Lot 42 is located across from the USF School of Music – Concert Hall near the Laurel Garage and Lot 9A is located near FAH (Fine Arts Hall) with a short walk up the MLK Plaza sidewalk to Theatre 1 and 2.

Park Mobile will work in these spaces for our visitors.

Please inform your students, families, and guests that they should plan to arrive early. Space will be available. This will guarantee they are not late for the start of the performance. Standard drop off locations and accessibility spaces are not affected by this project.
