- USF is home to the state's first and only **Business Honors Program**, affiliated with the Judy Genshaft Honors College, which blends rigorous coursework and research activities with special residential, service, international and applied learning activities. - **The Corporate Mentor Program**, based on the Tampa campus, pairs first-generation college students with a mentor who shares tips and guidance for a smooth transition from student to professional life. Students meet monthly with a management-level professional for first-hand insight into the corporate world, and become eligible for over \$100,000 in scholarships awarded each year. Apply early! Admissions decisions are made on a rolling basis beginning in late fall as applications are completed and all supporting documents are received. You may apply as early as August of your high school senior year. Freshman applications are considered for the spring, summer and fall semesters. Apply online at usf.edu/admissions.
