- USF is home to the state's first and only Business Honors Program, affiliated with the Judy Genshaft Honors College, which blends rigorous coursework and research activities with special residential, service, international and applied learning activities. - The Corporate Mentor Program, based on the Tampa campus, pairs first-generation college students with a mentor who shares tips and guidance for a smooth transition from student to professional life.
