 Program, affiliated with the Judy Genshaft Honors College,
 which blends rigorous coursework and research activities
 with special residential, service, international and applied

 or Tampa campus for one year and must meet additional
 admission requirements upon entering as a freshman. Learn

- The Corporate Mentor Program, based on the Tampa campus, pairs first-generation college students with a mentor who shares tips and guidance for a smooth transition from student to professional life.
