Starting salaries range from \$40,000 to \$85,000+ with top companies like Apple, Coca-Cola, Disney, Gartner, Honeywell, IBM, KnowBe4, and ReliaQuest.

Hands-On Learning

Marketing students develop valuable interpersonal, critical thinking, creative, and analytical skills through a curriculum that emphasizes experiential learning. Award-winning student organizations provide networking opportunities with executives, corporate field trips, and chances to participate in national conferences. Nearly 60% of marketing students secure internships, and our Marketing Practice Center links students with local companies for additional short-term paid projects.

Job Security

The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics projects that job growth in some marketing sub-disciplines (e.g., digital marketing) will exceed 30% in the next decade, with the general marketing field expected to grow nearly 10%, faster than the average for all occupations. The median annual wage for marketing managers was \$157,620 in 2023.

- USF is home to the state's first and only Business Honors **Program**, affiliated with the Judy Genshaft Honors College, which blends rigorous coursework and research activities with special residential, service, international and applied learning activities.
