OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSES:

To define the term "USF HIPAA designated record set" for the purpose of clarification for standard practices and procedures that reference the term and for purposes of compliance with HIPAA regulations. See 45 CFR § 164.501

STATEMENT OF INTERNAL GUIDELINES.

USF HIPAA covered health care components (Covered Components) maintain the following records that are defined as the USF HIPAA DRS: (1) the medical records and billing records about individuals maintained by or for Covered Components; and (2) any other record that is used, in whole or in part, by or for Covered Components to make decisions about individuals. The term "record" means any item, collection, or grouping of information that includes protected health information (PHI) and is maintained, collected, used, or disseminated by or for Covered Components.

USF HIPAA DRS is not limited to information contained in an electronic record, but also includes any non-duplicative, electronic or paper-based information that meets the term's definition.

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION.

The USF HIPAA DRS is subject to access by individuals. Health Information Management (HIM) at University of South Florida Tampa General Physicians is responsible for receiving and processing requests for access by individuals to request their protected health information under 45 CFR § 164.524.
