The PowerSchool Fund is used to support students from underrepresented populations, with a preference for students who are financially disadvantaged, working toward their teacher certification. Support may include but is not limited to awards of up to \$350 for testing fees, fingerprinting, background checks, and miscellaneous expenses related to Teacher Certification. To be eligible for consideration, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be currently enrolled students in the USF College of Education on any campus
- Fees must have been towards initial testing expenses, retakes are not eligible
- Applicant must not have previously received this scholarship

Application Procedures

- Form <u>must be</u> accompanied by receipts from associated certification fees
- Receipts must be for fees incurred Between January 2023 and July 2024
- Return this completed form and materials to EDUScholarships@usf.edu no later than Friday, April 11, 2025
- Awardees will be notified via their USF email.
