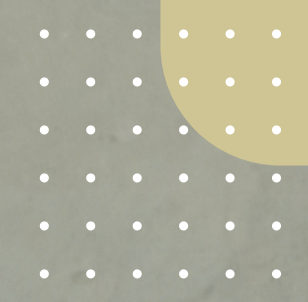


INTRODUCTION

Participate in face-to-face sessions, case study analyses, group discussions, role-playing exercises, and collaborative problem-solving activities.

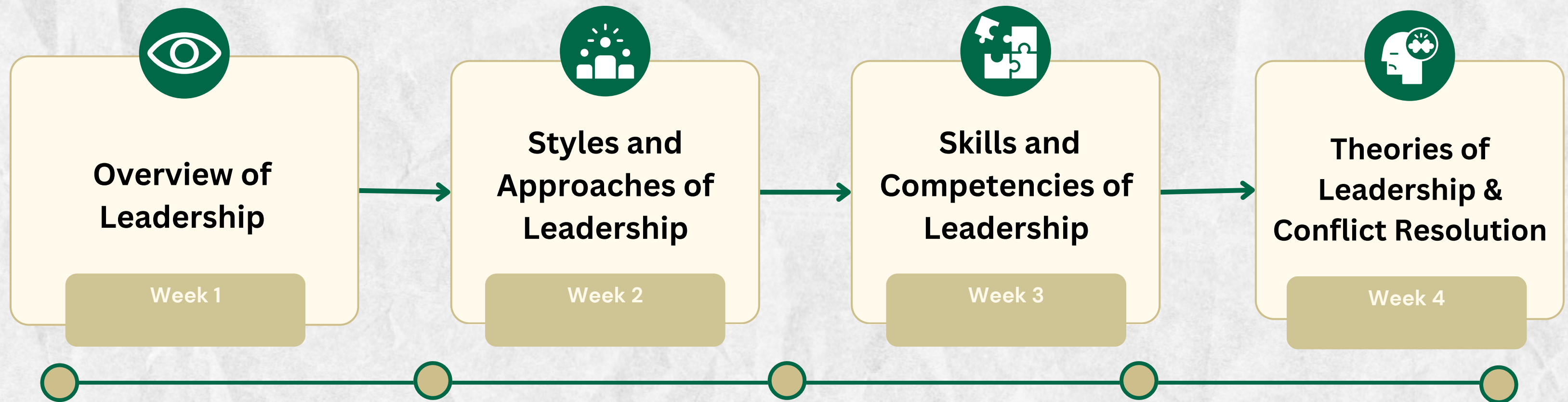


PEER MENTORING

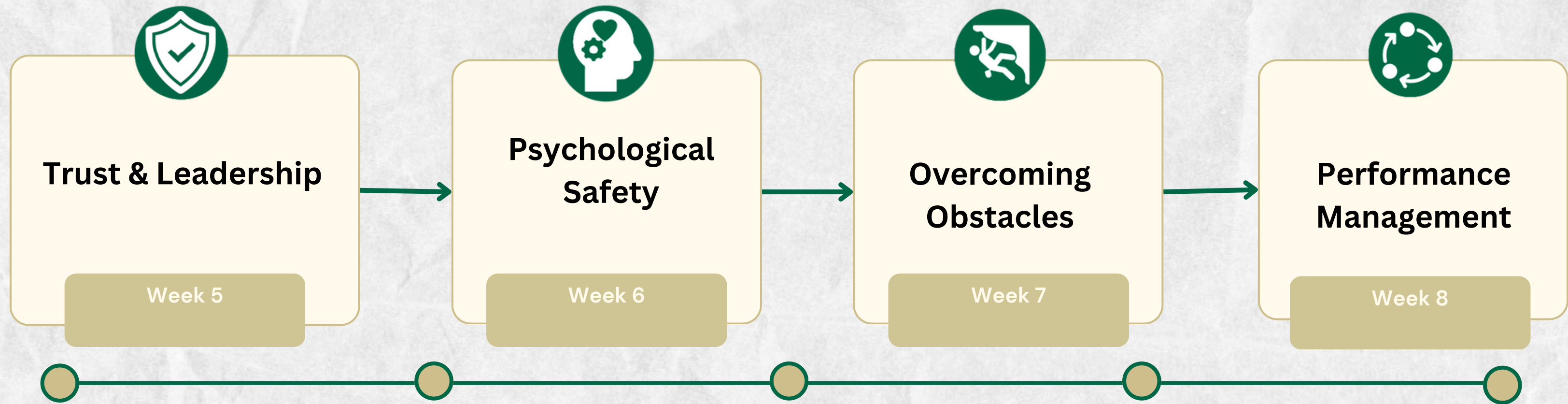
Each participant will be paired with a fellow classmate, fostering a supportive environment where they can engage in reflective discussions.
