

FINDING FEEDBACK ON CANVAS ASSIGNMENTS

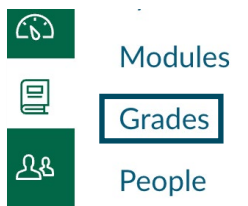
THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN COMMENTS AND ANNOTATIONS

Instructors often report that students encounter challenges to finding feedback on Canvas assignments. Sharing feedback is an essential part to maintaining a positive learner/instructor experience. Below are the steps to finding comments and annotations on graded assignments.

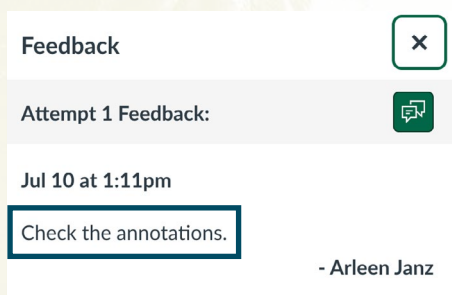
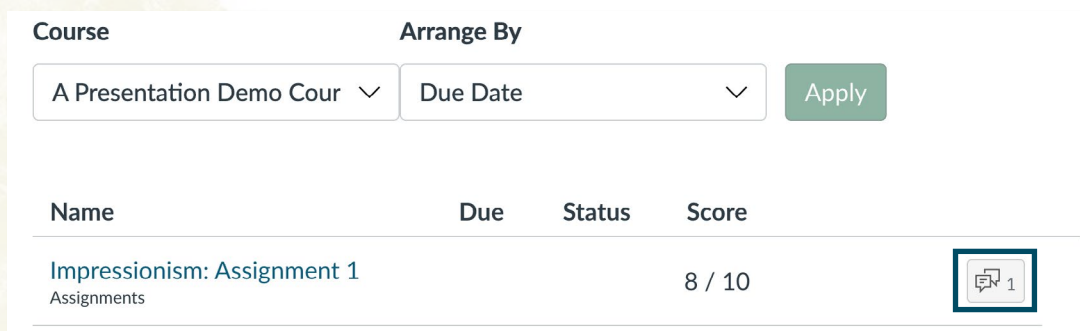
Finding Comments

01

Go to the **Grades** section of the course navigation menu.

If a comment has been posted to your assignment, a small discussion icon will appear to the right of your assignment with a number indicating how many comments exist. Select the **discussion icon** and the comments panel will open to view the details.



Finding Annotations

Annotations placed directly on an assignment submission are accessible through the **View Feedback** link.

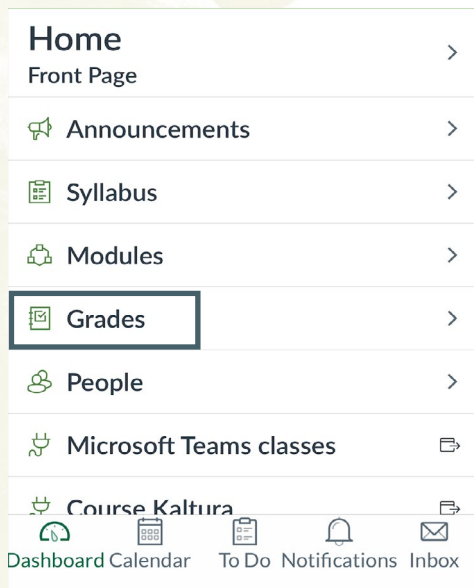

Viewing Feedback on a Mobile Device


The student experience will vary if they are accessing assignments and feedback through the Canvas App on a mobile device. Below are the steps to finding feedback on an Apple device.


