Old Business

• Update on Statewide General Education Committees: The GEC chair announced that the first meetings of the statewide general education committees tasked with identifying five (5) courses to be included in each of the five (5) subject areas will be held at USF on October 25, 2012. The question regarding whether the committees would focus on Learning Outcomes to identify courses vs. simply identifying course titles and numbers was raised. Associate Dean Moore encouraged the GEC to begin thinking about our FKL requirements and how we could integrate our dimensions within the state's required courses as well as within the remaining 15 hours of the General Education course requirements, retaining the important concepts of the FKL core curriculum.

New Business

• Strategic Plan Focus on USF as a Global Research Institution: Associate Dean Moore briefly reported on the first Strategic Plan Town Hall. The major emphasis of the strategic plan is on USF as a global research institution. The question was raised regarding how the term "global" is defined. Differences between "globalizing the curriculum" and "internationalizing the curriculum" were addressed, including how these differentiations impact the faculty and curriculum at USF. Kevin Yee suggested the metaphor of a fruit salad (international) vs. fruit smoothie (global) as one way of understanding the terminology.
