1. Welcome and Announcements: The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm.
2. Approval of Minutes: The minutes from the August 25, 2014 meeting were approved.
3. Old Business
 - a. QEP Update - Karla Davis-Salazar
 - The GEC approved the revised QEP/Global Citizens Project learning outcomes document (same content, but re-organized), as well as the online FKL course recertification form that incorporates the new Global FKL criteria, with the understanding that form will not be used until revisions to the GLC and HCD dimension definitions are completed. The definitions will be worked on by the Global FKL Implementation Team, and the results reported back to the GEC. The council was also supportive of using a checklist as opposed to a rubric for review of Global FKL courses.
4. New Business
 - a. Discussion of Review Procedures
 - Chair Scott Rimbey provided the council with a draft procedural document pertaining to FKL recertification reviews.
 - There was a suggestion to encourage reviewers to pay close attention to Core Areas as well as Dimensions when reviewing recertification proposals.
 - The GEC is in favor of requesting *specific* syllabi (using OASIS to select sections in a particular semester) for the recertification process, going forward, in an effort to streamline the procedure. This would be a form of quality control, ensuring that syllabi for FKL courses are consistent across all sections. There was a suggestion to involve department chairs, asking that they submit a statement regarding the consistency of their syllabi, in the event that many, diverse syllabi are received from the proposer.
 - There was much discussion regarding the need for more clarity in the official definition of a Capstone (CPST) course (as opposed to the clearer Writing Intensive – WRIN - definition). Specifically, the questions pertain to the following statement on the General Education Council website: “Capstone Courses provide students with a culminating educational experience, and should integrate multiple areas of knowledge and dimensions.” The GEC voted to form a subcommittee to investigate this. It will include Hunt Hawkins, David Payne, and Mariam Manzur-Leiva.
