- a. Discussion of INTO USF Proposal for 3-Year Dazhuan Degree Pathway
  - i. Dr. Glen Besterfield, Director of INTO USF, solicited the council's feedback on a proposed new pilot program for INTO USF. The goal of the "3-Year Dazhuan Degree Pathway" is to admit international students into the BSAS degree program with the possibility of progressing to an accelerated Graduate Pathway if the student successfully meets minimum Graduate pathway entrance requirements. The Graduate Council will also be presented with this information. Some of the initial questions put forth by UGC members included:
