The following is additional information for the Physical Education major:

- The College of Education has a SEPARATE APPLICATION PROCESS from that of the University of South Florida. Please allow enough time to apply and received acceptance to USF before applying to the College.
- The Physical Education program admits in the fall term only.
- All applicants to the COEDU (except Exercise Science) must take and pass all sections of the General Knowledge Test, including Math, Reading, Language, and Essay.
- All applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- EDF 1005 must have been passed with a C- or better. As long as all pre-requisite courses are complete or IN-PROGRESS the student may apply.
- Florida Teacher Certification Exams (Professional Education and Subject Area Exams) are required for graduation, as the degree is tied to earning a Florida Teaching Certificate. Students are encouraged to take these in fall of the last year to ensure enough time to retest if necessary. Certification will be reflected on the official transcripts.
- The Physical Education Program prepares students to model a lifelong dedication to physical fitness and holistic health. This program includes the study of motor behavior, physical skill development, coaching, curriculum development and assessment, pedagogy, and administration of physical activity programs. Students participate in clinical experiences each semester working closely with collaborating teachers in elementary and secondary school settings.
