The following is additional information for the Social Work major:

- Students can apply to start at USF during any semester, however, social work major cohorts will begin their coursework in either fall or spring semesters. The BSW Program is a full time, lock-step structured program with two different modalities: an in-person cohort and an online cohort. See program structure section below for more information. When applying through the Office of Admissions, please make sure to select the appropriate campus for the program modality you wish to pursue.
- Incoming transfer students are encouraged to make an academic advising appointment as a prospective student before applying to USF to ensure their coursework will transfer. Once ready to apply, transfer students can select the social work major on their USF admissions application. Students who meet the above outlined admissions criteria will begin the social work major upon admissions. Students who do not meet the admissions criteria yet will work with an academic advisor to complete it and then begin the social work major upon completion.
- All applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- All pre-requisite courses must have been passed with a minimum of a C (no C-). The SOW3203 (Intro to Social Work) must be passed with a minimum of a B (no B-).

Program Structure:

The BSW Program is a full time, lock-step structured program with two different modalities. The in-person cohort takes their coursework through the Tampa campus and will be on campus three days a week. The online cohort takes their coursework through the Sarasota-Manatee campus. It is a mixture of synchronous and asynchronous coursework, which means there will generally be two days of the week in which students are expected to be signed online for live virtual class sessions. Both cohorts include an 460 hour in-person field placement in the final semester of the program. This generally means that the student will be in their field placement Monday-Thursday from 8:00 – 5:00 PM with classes on Fridays.
