# Update From the Vice President



As we approach the final weeks of 2024, we are filled with gratitude for the support of our university community as well as our local and global partners. The end of each semester is special for USF World as we honor our graduating international students with the iconic Sash Ceremony, just days before the <u>Fall Commencement</u>, marking a meaningful transition into the holiday season.

On November 18, we celebrated two events that reflect USF's commitment to international education. The day began with the announcement from <u>Open Doors</u> that for the third consecutive year, USF was named the top destination for international students in Florida. The report is published by the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs and the Institute of International Education.

USF President Rhea Law then kicked off the grand opening of the new <u>Global Student Center</u> on the Tampa campus. With more than 7,000 international students from nearly 140 nations attending USF and more than 1,500 USF students studying abroad, global engagement has become a hallmark of a USF education —one that prepares our students for success in the global economy.

In recognition of the importance of the global business community to the vitality of the Tampa Bay region, USF World partnered with the French-American Business Council of West Florida to host the inaugural USF French Business Forum featuring France's Miami-based Counsel General M. Raphaël Trapp. The forum focused on innovation in life and health sciences, a key economic sector for the State of Florida. We look forward to January 24, 2025, when we will host British Consul General Rufus Drabble also based in Miami, and a panel of experts to explore "Growing Business between the U.K. and Tampa Bay." The event will serve as the launch for the British American Business Council in Tampa Bay and will formally welcome Honorary Consul Justine Assal to the region. The international community recognizes Florida as a business-friendly climate and USF as a key pipeline for highly skilled talent. These two events will pave the way for the second annual USF International Business Forum on March 13, 2025, focusing on "Al and the Future of Global Business."

We hope you will begin the new year with us by joining a timely discussion with USF Global and National Security Institute Executive Director General (Ret) Frank McKenzie U.S. Marines and Chief Global Officer at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and former U.S. Ambassador Barbara Stephenson on January 16, 2025. The event, "Post-U.S. Election Global Diplomacy & Security: Opportunities & Challenges," is open to the public and is sure to be an enlightening conversation.


