Downloadable I-20s

To provide additional security, we will stop sending I-20s to students via email and transition to a downloadable process within iStart. All eforms and processes will transition to the download model by March 1. When the eform or process is approved, an automatic email with instructions on accessing the downloadable I-20 will be sent to the student. Students can click on the download icon (it looks like a piece of paper with a down arrow) to access the document section and download their I-20. NOTE: If you haven't recently submitted an eform that requires an updated I-20, you will not have a download available.

Tax Time!

As a reminder, all F and J visa holders physically present in the United States for even one calendar day in the year 2023 are required to file a tax form in 2024, regardless of whether they worked or received income. This includes F-2 and J-2 dependents.

The OIS Tax Intern will conduct bi-weekly software assistance sessions in our offices in BEH 255 on Tuesdays and Fridays, February through April. There is no need to sign up to attend. The sessions will be offered on the following days and times:

- Fridays 10am to 12 pm

In the next few days, you will receive an email with a link to Sprintax. Please wait for the email to begin your filing. NOTE: The direct link in the email is the only way to receive the USF discount!

Also, wait until you have ALL of your documents to file. If you were employed, you will have a W-2 from each employer. If you received a taxable scholarship from USF, you will receive a 1042-S. Students will other forms of reportable income, such as interest from a bank account, will receive 1099 forms. If you receive a 1098-T form, please ignore it. This form applies to tax residents only!
