Cap Subject H-1B Approvals

For F-1 students with an approved change of status to H-1B with a start date of October 1, 2024, they should upload the change of status Approval Notice to iStart under *Immigration Updates – Update Visa Stamp or Status*. This will ensure the accuracy of the SEVIS record and allow our team to appropriately close out the SEVIS record. After closure, the student is no longer subject to the F-1 and OPT reporting requirements.

If the approval notice is H-1B <u>Consulate Processing</u>, this is not an automatic change to H-1B. The F-1 student needs to travel outside the US to a US consulate to obtain an H-1B visa stamp. Then re-enter the US using this new status. After the travel is complete, they would complete these e-forms - *Update Visa Stamp or Status* and *Update Port of Entry Stamp & I-94*. Immigration Document Update

If you update your passport, get a new visa, or travel outside the US, you need to update iStart with your new documents. Go to *Immigration Updates* and select *Update Passport*, *Update Visa*, or *Update I-94*. Updating these documents allows our office to best assist you in maintaining your immigration status.
